**East Contra Costa Irrigation District** is seeking a skilled and motivated individual to join our team as a Maintenance Worker I/II in Brentwood, CA. This is a skilled position where the candidate will use their existing skills while training and learning additional skills required to perform a variety of construction, repair, and maintenance tasks throughout the District. Candidates with construction and equipment operation skills are encouraged to apply. Starting pay will be adjusted based on relative previous experience and skills. This is a full-time benefited position that typically works an 8-hour schedule Monday-Friday.

**Salary:** Level I: \$31.32 - \$38.07 /hr.; Level II: \$36.26 - \$44.07 /hr.

### **Essential Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Enter confined spaces such as pipelines and vaults to perform repairs and inspections.
- Heavy manual labor, such as hand digging, mixing mortar and concrete, digging with hand shovel and various tools.
- Operates a variety of construction and related equipment such as gas and air powered saws, hammers, abrasive blasting equipment, drills, welding/torch equipment, woodchipper, air compressors.
- Form and pour concrete structures and flat work.
- Trench and install/replace concrete and plastic pipelines.
- Repair pumps, screens, buildings, gates, valves, canals, and wells.
- Assist in herbicide application and rodent abatement.
- Perform tree and vegetation removal and grinding.
- Operate heavy equipment including a backhoe-loader, dump truck front-end loader, tractor, skid steer loader, bulldozer, crane and trucks in the construction maintenance and repair of irrigation water facilities and equipment.
- Operates motor vehicles including pickups, dump trucks, tank trucks, semi-trucks and trailers.
- Installs, maintains, and repairs fences, gates, culverts, drains, sprinkler systems, and erosion control installations; sprays, cuts, disks, mulches, and burns brush and weeds; removes garbage, rubbish, or other materials and plants and maintains landscaping.

- Constructs and maintains access roads, road culverts and drainage systems and hard-surfaced roads.
- Prepares a variety of surfaces for painting; applies a variety of coatings and sealants to structures, machinery, and equipment.
- Constructs, maintains, and repairs wooden, concrete, and steel structures.
- Check job sites for hazards; determine precautions necessary for safe work site; ensure that employees and members of the public are protected by following appropriate safety precautions.
- Read plans and blueprints; makes field modifications as required to accomplish assigned work.
- Makes operating adjustments and minor repairs to equipment such as changing buckets and teeth and tightening loose bolts and hydraulic couplings.
- Secures equipment upon completion of the work.
- Performs a variety of general maintenance work as required.
- Responds to emergency calls in off-hours as required.
- Operating and maintaining a variety of hand and power tools used in maintenance and construction work including heavy equipment.
- Clears plant growth, trash and other materials from central canal and lateral distribution facilities and equipment; may apply herbicides and take animal control measures as assigned.
- Performs a variety of troubleshooting and maintenance work on a variety of facilities and equipment; may perform construction, maintenance and repair work as required.
- Drives a motor vehicle in the performance of the work.
- Responds to emergency calls in off-hours as required.
- Follow oral and written instructions.
- Establish and maintains cooperative relationships with those contacted during the course of work.
- Performs work safely.
- Informs management when issues arise.

**Working Conditions & Physical Requirements:**

- The work area can involve a working environment indoors as well as outdoors which could cause exposure to outdoor elements; proper safety attire will be required. Some areas can have loud noise, active machinery, high pressure fluid systems, electrical equipment, confined spaces, heights and depths, fumes, airborne particles, noxious gases, pathogens, and various chemicals.

The use of appropriate safety equipment will be mandatory in these areas to prevent hazardous contact.

- Must be able to sit, stand, stoop, twist, and bend at the waist, turn, kneel, squat, raise arms above shoulder height, grasp, reach, perform repetitive hand movements and fine coordination to operate and repair equipment, have vision sufficient to operate and service equipment, have hearing in the normal range with or without correction. **Qualifications:**

- Any combination of experience and training would likely provide the necessary skills to excel in this position.

**Preferred qualifications include:**

- Ability to work effectively with diverse teams and customers.
- Experience in a field that would likely provide candidate experience, knowledge, and skills to successfully perform construction and maintenance work. Successful candidates typically have experience and exposure to industries such as pipeline, underground utilities, concrete work, heavy equipment operation, road construction, agricultural operations, etc.
